## **Buprenorphine X-waiver Training in Ontario, OR- No charge**

### **REGISTER TODAY!**

The EOCCO, with support from the American Academy of Addiction Psychiatry\*, is offering Providers' Clinical Support System for Medication Assisted Treatment PCSS-MAT Waiver Training that enables a physician to obtain a Drug Enforcement Agent (DEA) waiver to prescribe **buprenorphine** products for opioid dependence. There is **no cost** for providers to attend the training. The first half of the training will occur online and the second half will occur in-person.

**Pre-registration and online work are required before the in-person portion of the course. Please register and Maggie McLain McDonnell will send you the link to the online work.**

This course will educate attendees on the use of buprenorphine and other treatments for substance abuse and alcoholism. The use of buprenorphine in pain management will also be addressed.

### **Who:**

Clinicians (MDs, DOs). This course is limited to the first 20 providers who register. NPs and PAs may register for the course and it will count towards their waiver training requirements.
