If you're working with a pregnant EOCCO member who wants additional support throughout the pregnancy, labor, and postpartum process, refer them to one of our birth doulas! The member will be matched to a doula in their area within four weeks of referral (usually sooner).

EOCCO Community Benefit Initiative Reinvestment (CBIR) Grant Open January 31- March 31, 2025 | Learn more here The Community Benefit Initiative Reinvestment (CBIR) grants fund one-year long projects that aim to improve access to quality care. Applicants may apply for up to \$50,000 and must be able to demonstrate how EOCCO members directly benefit.

NEW! EOCCO Supporting Health for All through Reinvestment (SHARE) Grant Open January 31- March 28, 2025 | <u>Learn more here</u>

The SHARE application is designed to provide funding to projects addressing Social Determinants of Health and Equity (SDOH-E). SDOH-E projects include housing, transportation, food, utilities, safety, education, and community health beyond clinic walls. Funding ranges from \$15,000-\$250,000.

Oregon's 2024 Regular Legislative Session is in full swing, and there's a handful of THW-related bills preparing to be introduced and voted on. This includes:

- All THWs: SB 161, SB 529
- CHWs: HB 2216, HB 2751
- Doulas: SB 690, SB 692, SB 693, SB 691 & SB 695
- Peers: HB 2954

To track these bills, provide public comment, and get involved, visit the <u>Oregon</u> <u>State Legislature</u>.
